Dear Pathfinder Families,

As I mentioned in my previous email, the Attestation and Itinerary are quite intrusive, but necessary in lieu of testing. They also provide valuable contact tracing information in the event we need it. In light of this, I ask that you be specific about your visit plans and disclose any and all contacts with people outside the household during your visitation. In addition, we are limiting length of home visits to two weeks. If a visit extends beyond two weeks, we will consider it an extended visit and re-entry will require testing and quarantine.

You will schedule home visits with your House Manager or Residential Team Leader (RTL) at least a week ahead of time. They will ask you a lot of questions as part of completing the Home Visit Itinerary. Because there is a screening and attestation requirement, we ask that all pick-ups and drop-offs take place Monday-Friday at the Kennedy Willis Center: 9:00 am-11:00 am/ 2:00 pm-4:00 pm. This also allows us to receive items back from the home visit and place them in storage for 24 hours and disinfect.

As staff, we are so happy for you and your family member to be reuniting. We have taken great pride in keeping your family member safe and look forward to working together to continue this success.

A word of advice if I may: You may be thinking, "I need to celebrate this reunion or make up for lost time." You may be thinking, "I have to do a lot of things during this initial visit, invite lots of people to the house to visit or resume prior visit routines." I would suggest simply **BE** with your family member.

Yesterday, I was on the phone with a mom and she said, "I just want to be close, watch a movie, order out, take a walk...nothing monumental." I replied, "Perfect." There will be time for so much more. If there is one thing I have learned through all this is that your family member is far more resilient to change than I gave them credit for. Follow the Pathfinder CREED: Be Healthy, Be Kind, Be Patient and KEEP Pathfinder on your MIND while visiting with your family member.
